Major Activities:

- 24 Hour Study Space- Alison Regan gave an update on the Libraries' study conducted in December 2015
- Library Strategic Plan: received feedback from Council members about the Libraries' strategic plan
- Celebration of Teaching Awards- changed wording of awards, offered feedback for awards
- UCIPD and Community Relations: In December, Council met with the new UCI Police Chief. Discussed general topics such as police officer recruitment and campus safety. In May, representatives from the Academic Council on Faculty Welfare, Diversity, and Academic Freedom (CFW) attended the meeting to discuss the UCIPD University Hills incident and garner feedback for moving the issue forward.
- Online Learning: tackled various issues with scheduling
- Student Athlete Policies: provided feedback for two forms

- Canvas Pilot replacing EEE: received overview of pilot implementation
