Responsibilities of the Council include,

- Make recommendations regarding policies on admissions, enrollments, and outreach activities to the administration and to the Academic Senate, and provide faculty coordination for outreach activities
- Work with BOARS [Board of Admissions and Relations with Schools] on matters related to undergraduate admission. The chair sits on the BOARS subcommittee and reports to CUARS.
- Monitor outreach programs towards academic enrichment of the campus through a diverse student body, and advise the campus admin. On the disbursement of funds designated for such programs.

Key Issues Discussed during 2015/2016:

- The Increased Recruitment and enrollment of non-residents in the last coupler years by UC. 52% increase in resident applicants but only 10% increase in admissions in the last 10 years.
- Over the past three years nearly 16,000 nonresidents were admitted [the University lowered the admission standard]
- Admitted residents were denied their campus of choice, yet non-residents were always admitted to their campus of choice.

UCI representatives [Morales & Yunek] admitted stated that each campus has addressed this issue differently; that UCI has tried to meet the requirements to maximize the admission of residents
