Charge

The Committee on Professional Development shall monitor and provide leadership on ongoing professional development and mentoring opportunities for LAUC-I members. Coordinate LAUC-I activities associated with the LAUC (System-wide) "Call for Research Proposals, UC Research Grants for Librarians." Undertake other duties as directed by the LAUC-I Chair and the Executive Board.

Grants

In fall 2016, LAUC-I submitted five presentation grants and one research grant, all of which were funded or partially funded. In spring 2017, LAUC-I submitted six presentation grants, all of which were funded or partially funded. In spring 2017, grant awardees submitted reports on use of funds to LAUC general.

Feedback on Grant Application Guidelines

Provided feedback to LAUC general on clarifying grant application criteria. Specifically, we asked that Guidelines

- Be more specific about what is "research."
- Reconcile language about use of research grant funds for personnel between "outside librarian series" and later language on funds for other types of personnel.
- Require one to disclose having already received other funds; could be in budget of the application or otherwise.

Committee Chair Carla wrote to thank everyone for edits, and drafted revised grant guidelines that follow the same spirit and different organization. Carla will send revisions to the LAUC Executive Board for review.

Carla helpfully offered these ideas for other projects for future committees:

- Revise and update the Research Grant Cover Sheet
- Convert forms, such as the Cover Sheet, to PDF forms that can be filled out on a computer
- Develop a list of links to outside funding and grant sources, such as IMLS
- Develop an FAQ for the grants program
