- 2. [2 min] Approve General Membership Meeting Minutes from Nov 30, 2020
 - Motion by Scott Stone; Seconded by Annette Buckley
 - Minutes are approved
- 3. [5 min] Congratulations to Julia Gelfand, ACRL Librarian of the Year!
 - Julia would like to share this award with everyone at UCI.
 - Julia recommends reading: Creativity in Research: Cultivate Clarity, Be Innovative, and Make Progress in your Research Journey.
- 4. [5 min] Budget/HR Update: Kevin Ruminson, Admin AUL
 - Budget:
 - Governor released preliminary budget proposal in January; kicks-off the budget process.
 - Revisions expected in May.
 - We will find out the budget in July/August.
 - Proposal restores a third of last year's cuts.
 - Some additional one-time money given to the system.
 - Not a full restoration of what we lost, but positive (with some strings attached).
 - Compared to other states, we are in good shape.
 - UCI is well positioned within the UC system.
 - Expect it to be a challenging, but not disastrous, year.
 - HR:
 - No librarian recruitments.
 - Minimal staff recruitments.
 - Minimal turnover in the Libraries.
 - In position to recruit if needed.
- 5. [5 min] Leadership Council Update: Kevin Ruminson, Admin AUL
 - Moderately quiet period.
 - Preliminary discussions on open education resources and textbook affordability programs.
 - Update on this year's strategic goals.
 - · Standing items:
 - Reopening plans
 - UCI Black Thriving Initiative and DEI (new standing item)
 - Discussing post-pandemic visioning for the Libraries.
 - What will trigger our widespread return to campus and what will that look like?
 - Meeting culture questions and considerations being explored.
 - Will look to LAUC-I for ideas/comments and individually.
- 6. [5 min] Law Library update: Amy Atchison, Deputy Director
 - · Services are still currently remote.
 - Library is open to 10 law students for study space with keycard access.
 - Expect alumni to use the library for the bar exam later this month.
 - Contingency planning committee how to reopen for Fall Semester
 - At minimum: offer the same access as now with the expectation to be open to more students.
 - Plan to continue keycard access to control the number of people who enter the library.
 - Right now, only approximately 3 students are in the building at a time.

 - Began discussing supplemental charge in January; plan is to meet monthly this year with the goal of having a draft plan submitted to try out next year.
