Charge:

The RPDC shall monitor and provide leadership on ongoing research, professional development, and mentoring opportunities for LAUC-I members. 1. Coordinate LAUC-I activities associated with the LAUC (System wide) Call for Research Proposals, UC Research Grants for Librarians. 2. Undertake other duties as directed by the LAUC-I Chair and the Executive Board.

Supplemental Charges (if applicable):

The 2018-2019 LAUC-I Report, Highlighting Librarian Achievements, focuses on recommendations for internal sharing of information within the UCI Libraries as part of fostering a culture of scholarship, professional accomplishment, and intellectual growth. It was decided that this should be incorporated into the RPDC charge. The Supplemental Charge for the committee is for a two-year period, 2020-2022:

LAUC-I Research & Professional Development Committee (RPDC) RPDC shall investigate and then implement the inclusion of this permanent Duty: highlighting LAUC-I members' professional achievements.

• RPDC shall determine what constitutes a reasonable scope for this Duty, i.e. what new responsibilities the Committee can assume to help fulfill this Duty, without over-burdening its members.

• RPDC shall determine whether its current Charge in the LAUC-I Bylaws sufficiently reflects this Duty, or whether the charge should be updated to reflect this Duty; if the latter, then RPDC will propose an Amendment to the LAUC-I Bylaws.

• RPDC shall document its new responsibilities and accompanying workflows as it sees fit for the benefit of incoming RPDC members.

Summary of Activities:

- The Committee worked to fulfill its charge related to providing leadership on research funding by encouraging LAUC-I members to apply for LAUC Research and Professional Development grants. While no LAUC-I members applied for a grant this year, the Chair did participate in system-wide discussions on the LAUC Research and Professional Development Committee to provide feedback on grant proposals from other LAUC chapters.
- 2. The Committee implemented the Supplementary Charge that was given to us by the LAUC-I Executive Board. To this, we sent out the first call for LAUC-I members to self-report their professional achievements using a Google form. This information was put on a publicly accessible page on the LAUC-I website (https://lauci.lib.uci.edu/member-achievements). Furthermore, Committee member Sara Heimann spearheaded an online event that provided LAUC-I members who had previously submitted achievements to give a brief lightning presentation. This event had seven presenters and twenty-two attendees.

Recommendations for the Future:

1. Decide whether the Supplemental Charge will be integrated into the standing Charge for the Committee. If so, update documentation accordingly.
