Program: Opportunities in Librarianship.

This was a panel Program on library and archives careers for an audience of library staff. The panel consisted of Gerry Munoff, Manuel Urrizola, Rina Vecchiola, Bill Landis, Carole Hughes, and Kristine Kasianovitz, and represented a wide range of potential career paths for library and information professionals. Each panelist spoke about his or her path to librarianship and past and current specializations, and answered questions from the audience. The session was moderated by Joan Ariel.

Rina Vecchiola addressed special libraries (visual resources, museum) and personal value of library school. Kristine Kasianovitz focused on making the transition from library assistant to librarian. Manuel Urrizola spoke on working in technical services and as a cataloger, and participation in professional organizations. Bill Landis spoke about careers in archives and manuscripts. Carol Hughes spoke on work in non-academic library settings and the value of advanced degrees in addition to the MLS. Gerry Munoff focused on working in library administration.

To supplement the and encourage dialog between attendees and librarians a list of "resource librarians" (librarians willing to talk with staff interested in librarianship) was compiled and distributed.

March 10, 2004 12-1pm, LL 460 Lunch with LAUC-I

This meeting was devoted to a discussion of responses to the survey distributed after the Opportunities in Librarianship program. Many suggestions were made regarding how such a program might be improved in the future.
