I've been at UCI for three years. My first professional position was at the Bentley Historical Library at the University of Michigan. I had earned a Master of Science in Information there at the School of Information in 2000, specializing in Archives and Records Management. I've served in a couple leadership roles recently, including as Chair of the LAUC-I Program Committee this year and Chair of the WAC Content and Assessment group.

My participation in library-wide activity has also included instruction: I volunteered to teach the Writing 39C library orientation and I've taught a plagiarism education workshop that I had helped design. I'm active in the UC Archivists Council: I serve as webmaster and as liaison to the UC Records Management Committee. I'm also professionally active: I've presented two papers at Society of California Archivists meetings, I will chair a session this fall at the Society of American Archivists (SAA) meeting, and I edit the newsletter for the SAA Electronic Records Section.
