- How do we help a candidate know about the area to which they might move? When is this staged?
- What are the expectations and role of a search committee?
  - How does a search committee function?
  - What does "confidentiality" mean to search committee members and other participants in the process?
  - What criteria are used to develop balance in forming the search committee?
  - Who crafts the job description?
  - What is the weight of the search committee's recommendation in various parts of the process?
  - After the search committee has made its recommendation, what are the next steps in the process leading to appointment?
  - How valuable is the feedback that library staff submit to the process?
  - Other related questions or issues?
- We also want to better inform LAUC-I members of the responsibilities and role of the LRC in the appointment process. How has that changed?
