- **5.** Librarians@UCI web site activities-- Google Webmaster Analytics and Net Tracker statistics for LAUC-I website Brown
 - Google Webmaster Analytics and Net Tracker statistics for LAUC-I website

Mitchell Brown demonstrated and reviewed the Google Webmaster Tools to track web activity. It has characteristics of Net Tracker and uses Dashboard to graph usage. It generates weekly reports and targets individual documents. It does not simply count hits to the overall site, but groups searches into a custom search of links. "Things to do in Orange County" has the most hits. Where librarians live in OC can be graphed. Determines entrance path and follows search pattern. Helps target audience using site

and how to improve user access to information on the site. Terms should be embedded on a higher level of the website to reach more users. Terms should be more common or relevant to make searching easier.

• Faculty profiles for librarians – used by others shown by number of hits

The ALC with PDC is holding sessions for librarians to update their profiles and include photos.
