1. Agenda review (All)

2. Approve minutes: LAUC-I ExBd, Oct. 6. (Hildebrand)

- The LRC met more than once in the period prior to Oct. 6.

3. News/Announcements (Brown)

- Kudos Award for Librarians
  - Mitchell met with Deb Sunday regarding the Kudos award for librarians. Rather than having separate committees for staff and librarians, Sunday proposes one committee of 5 or so individuals. The committee should be comprised of both librarians and library staff. LAUC-I will have the option of recommending individuals for service on the committee. The process for the awards will begin in March with the deadline in May (a shorter calendar than previously). Nothing further is known at this time regarding a recognition award for students.
- CROP brochure.
  - Sunday feels it is a LAUC-I document, ours to build and distribute with input from Executive Committee. Same for website on working and living in OC.
- IMLS Grant for professional librarians.
  - This is perhaps too ambitious to pursue at this time of year. In the future, with more lead time, it might be worth working on this with UCLA and SJSU library schools.
- Presentation of online faculty review system from Rhonda Loudon, Academic Services, at General Meeting for Academic Services
  - LRC had asked if they could use this software. Would take ca. 1 year to implement if we adopted the system.

- Current funds: \$ 426.46. We haven't yet received our budget.

- A location on campus has not yet been identified. The program will begin around 9-10am and end at 3pm.
